

About the Conference: Preparing for Hypergrowth

Texas's population—like Seattle's—has grown exponentially. According to the City of Seattle, the city's population grew 22% from 2010 to 2020, continuing more than two decades of hypergrowth in the Seattle area. And Texas is following in Seattle's footsteps. From 2010 to 2020, Texas's population grew approximately 16%—more than any other state. Most of Texas's growth occurred in areas spanning from Dallas and Fort Worth to Austin and San Antonio to Houston.
