Perceptions, Reality, & the Future of Texas Law Enforcement

Join us in Victoria, Texas as we delve into critical topics shaping the current state and future of policing in Texas. Walk away with a look behind the badge and a humanized approach to relationship building with law enforcement across Texas communities.

Key themes and topics to be explored include:

- **Texas Law Enforcement: Past, Present, and Future:** Reviewing the evolution of law enforcement policies in Texas.
- **Psychology & Pressures of Policing:** Exploring the mental and physical challenges and psychological dynamics within police work.
- **Policing- Reality vs. Perception:** Examining the gap between actual safety measures/data and public perception and how this affects the public's feeling of safety, economic development, and residential growth.
- **Public Trust and Support for Police in Texas:** Using case studies and real-world events to assess public trust in local law enforcement before and after major incidents.
- **The Impact and Influence of Women in Policing:** This session explores research that shows women officers use less force, are named in fewer complaints, and bring unique strengths to policing, leading to better outcomes for crime victims and improving community trust.

CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION & CONFIDENTIALITY GUIDELINES

The Texas Lyceum creates a unique environment that encourages open, candid dialogue on critical issues facing our state. To preserve this atmosphere, all participants—including sponsors and their designated guests—are asked to observe the following guidelines:

- **Confidentiality (Chatham House Rule):** Sessions are conducted under the Chatham House Rule. Participants may use the information received, but neither the identity nor the affiliation of speakers, panelists, or other participants may be revealed outside the conference without their consent.
- **Sponsor Access:** Registered sponsor representatives are warmly welcomed at all conference programming—including both daytime sessions and evening events—as well as designated excursions. However, please note that only those individuals specifically registered through their sponsoring organization may attend.
- **Non-Transferability:** Sponsor invitations and passes are extended to specific individuals designated by the sponsoring organization. These are **non-transferable** and may not be reassigned, shared, or otherwise used to grant access to unapproved individuals.
- **Safe Space for Speakers:** All participants, including sponsors and their guests, are expected to uphold the confidentiality and discretion that allows speakers to engage candidly and constructively. The Texas Lyceum operates under the Chatham House Rule.
- **Media Policy:** Attendance is not open to the general public. Members of the media must receive advance approval from the Texas Lyceum and check in with staff upon arrival.

By participating, sponsors and guests agree to these guidelines, which are essential to maintaining the integrity, privacy, and productive atmosphere of the Lyceum.
