Constructing Our Path: How We Build Infrastructure

Texas is entering a pivotal era of growth—one that demands smarter planning, stronger systems, and bold leadership. Our infrastructure is the backbone that keeps the state moving: the highways that connect our communities, the ports and airports that fuel global trade, the dams and water systems that secure our future, and the coastal defenses that protect millions. As Texas expands, so does the urgency to understand the full lifecycle of infrastructure—who plans it, who pays for it, who builds it, who owns it, and who maintains it.

The Texas Lyceum’s 2026 conference, **Constructing Our Path**, brings these questions to the forefront through two days of programming designed to unpack the complexity behind the systems Texans rely on every day. From megaproject financing and energy reliability to coastal protection and water security, attendees will hear directly from the policymakers, engineers, economists, and industry leaders who shape the state’s-built environment.

This year’s agenda will guide participants through every phase of infrastructure development—beginning with the exploration of “Who Builds Texas?” and concluding with in-depth looks at funding strategies, long-term maintenance challenges, and the interconnected systems that power our daily lives. Speakers may include top officials from TxDOT, the Texas Water Development Board, the General Land Office, the Public Utility Commission, ERCOT, TCEQ, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and local leaders from across the Gulf Coast.

Sponsoring this event places your organization at the heart of the statewide conversation on infrastructure—positioning you alongside the people and institutions driving Texas’ future.

Our key topics will be:

1 - Who Decides and Plans Texas Infrastructure

How infrastructure priorities are set across Texas—examining the roles of state agencies, local governments, regional planners, elected officials, and private partners. This includes how politics, equity, growth, and economic development influence what gets built and where.

2- How Texas Funds and Delivers Major Infrastructure Projects

An in-depth look at how large-scale infrastructure is financed, including federal grants, state programs, local bonds, public-private partnerships, and private capital. This topic demystifies who pays, how funding decisions are made, and how financial structures shape project timelines and outcomes.

3- Sustaining and Connecting Critical Infrastructure Systems

How Texas maintains what it builds and prepares for future challenges—focusing on asset management, resilience, deferred maintenance, and the interconnected nature of water, energy, transportation, and flood infrastructure. This includes lessons learned from past disruptions and planning for long-term reliability.

The Texas Lyceum is the premier non-profit, non-partisan, statewide leadership organization focused on identifying the next generation of top Texas leaders. We have 96 active Directors from around the state, and our alumni go on to serve our communities, state, and nation in significant ways. Texas Lyceum alumni have served as President of the United States, White House Staff, U.S. Senators & House Members, Ambassadors, the Governor's Mansion, the Texas Legislature, and leading corporations. Throughout our 42-year history, we have explored topics ranging from education to energy, and criminal justice to banking. Our goal is to inform, engage, and spark debate among Texans about the important issues facing our state.
